I have passed a national board certification exam which is specific to pediatrics, and I collaborate with the entire health care team.

A Focus on Cure and Care

Along with clinical services, I advocate for health promotion, disease prevention, and health education for your child. I spend time learning about your child's physical and emotional well-being during visits.

Family-Centered Care

You play an active role in your child's health care. CPNPs respect and encourage that relationship, and see you as a partner in the management of your child's health.

What I Do

As a partner in your child's health, I can:

- Diagnose and treat common pediatric illnesses.
- Perform routine well visit check-ups.
- Order and interpret diagnostic tests like lab work and x-rays.
- Prescribe medication and other treatments.
- Manage your child's care over time and initiate referrals to other health care providers.
